Location

Gothenburg University, Sven Lovén Centre for Marine Infrastructure. Tjärnö. Located on the coast 150 kilometers north of Gothenburg.

Travel

One train/bus every 2 hours from Gothenburg Central Station to Strömstad. The trip takes 2 hours and 30 minutes. Pick-up will be organized from Strömstad station from 13.00 on Saturday and back on Monday.

Accommodation

Single rooms with bedding and towels included. All meals and the Monday morning boat-trip are included

Total cost is SEK 3000 which is equivalent to € 300. Payment can be made either by credit card at the site or by invoice after the workshop. **Cash payment is not accepted.**

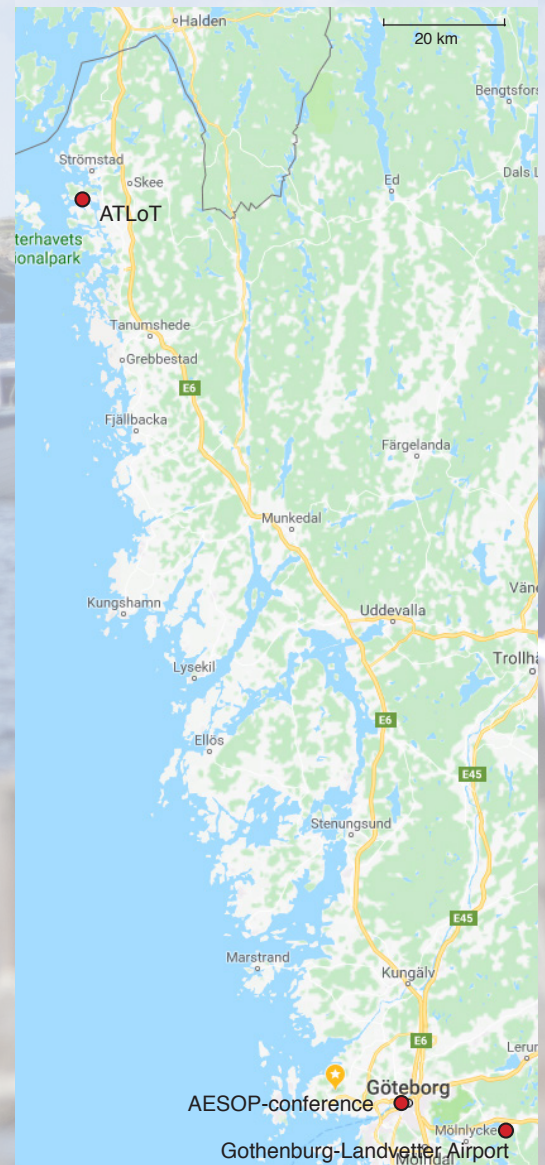
