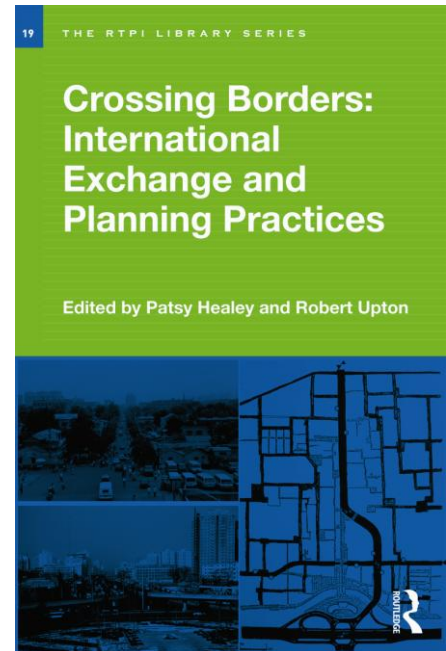
International Exchange and Planning Practices
