There is the opportunity to write a dissertation within the project. The self-achieved work results can be used to receive a Ph.D.

The scholarship is $1.100 \in \text{per month for a period of 3 years.}$

Area of responsibility: PhD 1: urban and regional planning / conflicts in land use

Innovative solutions for the climate adapted development of the metropolis of Hamburg shall be investigated within the project. Within the range of regional planning it shall be analyzed which utilization claims to space exist and to what extent conflicts in land use occur due to the dealing with the consequences of climate change. On this basis methods to deal with these conflicts are to be developed.

Requirements:

Above-average university degree related to the described field (e.g. M.Sc. in Spatial Planning, Urban and Regional Planning, Environmental Planning)

Good ability to communicate and to work in a team

Personal initiative and independent work

Experiences in scientific work
