Duties and Responsibilities

The UCL Bartlett School of Planning is heading up a consortium on the recently-funded EPSRC project: Challenging Lock-In in Urban Energy Systems (CLUES). This project will explore the expansion of decentralised energy initiatives at the urban scale in the context of the need to deliver deep cuts in carbon emissions.

Two research associate positions are available to work on this project. One is for 6 months in the first instance, focusing on developing a database of decentralised energy initiatives; this post will run from 1 October 2010 to 31 March 2011 inclusive. The other is for two years in the first instance and will run from 1 October 2010 to 30 September 2012 inclusive; this post will take a major role in the management of the project, in dissemination activities and in developing the synthesis of the project findings.

Key Requirements

For both posts, applicants will be expected to hold a PhD in an area relevant to the project.

For the six-month post (reference number 1146046), applicants will be expected to have a good knowledge of bibliographic and internet research techniques. They must be well organised and capable of working to a tight deadline. For this post a part-time appointment would be considered.

For the two-year post (reference number 1146040), candidates should have excellent management and communication skills, be flexible and self-directing; prior knowledge of energy systems will be an advantage.
