The HafenCity University Hamburg, Department Urban Planning and Regional Development, awards a **postdoctoral fellowship** within the junior research group **MetroKlim: Urban Open Space and Settlement Structure for a Climate Adapted Development of the Metropolis of Hamburg**, beginning on **01.09.2010**. Part of the PostDocs assignments is independent research work, the cooperation at research projects and the guidance and coordination of the junior research group. Supporting national and international cooperations and collaborating with the doctoral candidates is also part of the job.

The scholarship is $1.600 \in \text{per month for a period of 3 years.}$

Area of research: control of settlement and open space structures

Innovative solutions for the climate adapted development of the metropolis of Hamburg shall be investigated within the project. The area of research of the PostDoc is the development of strategies to control the settlement and open space structures and the integration of climatic compensating areas under consideration of the preservation of biodiversity. This includes an innovative handling of the field of urban open space and settlement structures in context of climate change adaption through the combination of planning and natural science.

Requirements:

Ph.D. in Urban Planning and Regional Development or equal qualification

Good ability to communicate and to work in a team

Personal initiative and independent work

Experiences in scientific work and ability to publicize
