

## Tenured Professor, Housing

A tenured full-professorial position is available at the Harvard Graduate School of Design, in collaboration with the Harvard Kennedy School, for a senior scholar with a primary focus in the field of housing and with a wide-ranging interest in urbanization and the built environment. It is envisaged that the successful candidate would be primarily placed within the Department of Urban Planning and Design. S/He would also be an active member of the Joint Center for Housing Studies, an applied research center that concentrates on issues of housing economics, public policy, planning, and design. S/He would play a leading role in helping to shape the Center's direction in research. The GSD places particular emphasis on cross-disciplinary activities and expects the successful candidate to be actively engaged with other disciplines and programs within the school, in the Master in Design and doctoral programs, as well as in the Harvard Kennedy School, where it is expected that there will be an affiliated appointment.
