

The Karslruhe Institute for Technology (KIT) is a merger of the Universitaet Karlsruhe (or "Fridericiana") and the National Research Center Karlsruhe. This ground-breaking step led to the foundation of an institution with 8,000 employees, 18,500 students and almost 300 academics, funded with an annual budget of 700 million Euros.

The position will also involve teaching in line with the department's teaching portfolio of "Spatial and Infrastructure Planning" of the department for Civil Engineering.
