

## **Research Assistant Cardiff University School of City and Regional Planning**

We are looking to appoint a Research Assistant to work with a team of experienced researchers on an ESRC-funded project, *Delivering Renewable Energy Under Devolution* (RES-062-23-2526). The project aims to understand the impacts of devolution in the UK on the provision of renewable energy, looking at how the devolved administrations have formulated policy objectives, adjusted the choice, nature and settings of policy instruments, and influenced the delivery of new renewable energy capacity.

Your role in the project would be to assist with the setting up, execution and analysis of fieldwork, which will be conducted in England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Brussels. You will work closely with project staff and contribute to other project activities, such as workshops and conferences, the reporting of outcomes, as well as day-to-day project management.

You will hold a good postgraduate degree in a relevant social science discipline, preferably a PhD, and ideally you will have some experience of producing high quality of written output based on research.
